CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS Roger F. Reynolds has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Underground through well and ditches for Irrigation and domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: In the SW 1/4 NE 1/4 Sec. 9, T. 4 S., R. 67 E., or at a point from which the N.W. corner of said Sec. 9 bears N. 62° 46' W., 3,677 feet situated in Lincoln County, State of Nevada.

Now Know YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 46, Statutes of 1937 has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Amount of appropriation 0.00073 c.f.s. or 20 gallons per hour

* Period of use, from April 1st to October 31st of each year

Date of priority of appropriation April 30, 1951

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use: Water developed by means of an 8-inch cased well 43 feet deep equipped with plunger pump and conveyed through ditches for the irrigation of 4.5 acres of land located within the SW 1/4 NE 1/4 Sec. 9, T. 4 S., R. 67 E., M.D.B.&M.

*Domestic water use January 1st to December 31st of each year.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
