CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Clair Whipple has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from White River and Hot Creek Channel through reservoir and ditches for Irrigation

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: Within NE 1/4 NE 1/4 Sec. 23, T. 5 N., R. 60 E., or at a point from which the NE corner of said Section 23 bears N. 30 E., 1,070 feet situated in Nye County, State of Nevada.

Now Know Ye, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 46, Statutes of 1937 has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: Clair Whipple
Post-office address: Box 42, Ely, Nevada
Amount of appropriation: 10 c.f.s. and not to exceed 1853 acre-feet per year
Period of use, from October 1st to June 1st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation: June 28, 1948

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
