CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Kenneth Gubler has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Underground through well, pump and troughs for Stockwatering

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: In the NE 1/4 NW 1/4 Sec. 28, T. 12 N., R. 62 E. or at a point from which the N.E. corner of said Section 28 bears N. 70° 53' 30" E., 2,867.5 feet situated in White Pine County, State of Nevada.

Now Know YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 46, Statutes of 1937 has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: George H. Gubler
Post-office address: Lund, Nevada
Amount of appropriation: 0.0016 c.f.s. or sufficient to water 50 head of cattle
Period of use, from: January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation: July 2, 1951

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use: Water developed by means of a well 80 feet deep cased with 4-inch casing. Well equipped with 69 feet of 2-inch pump column, pump jack and gasoline motor. Water diverted to troughs for the watering of 50 head of cattle within the NE 1/4 NW 1/4 Section 28, T. 12 N., R. 62 E.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
