CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, E. D. and Beatrice Halstead has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Monte Cristo Spring through ditch and catch basin for Stockwatering purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: In the NE 1/4 SE 1/4 Sec. 20, T. 16 N., R. 57 E., or at a point from which the S.W. corner of said Section 20 bears S. 67° 38' 27" W., 5,255 feet situated in White Pine County, State of Nevada.

Now Know YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 46, Statutes of 1937 has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator E. D. and Beatrice R. Halstead
Post-office address Duckwater, Nevada
Amount of appropriation 0.015 c.f.s. or sufficient to water 100 cattle and 2000 sheep
Period of use, from May 1st to October 1st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation August 30, 1951

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water conveyed from Monte Cristo Spring through 4.742 feet of Vee shaped ditch 1 foot deep to a 24' x 24' catch basin and there used to water 100 head of cattle and 2000 head of sheep. Place of use is within the NW 1/4 SW 1/4 Sec. 20, T. 16 N., R. 57 E.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
