CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, B. D. Davis has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Underground through well, pump and ditches for Irrigation

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: Within the NW 1/4 SW 1/4 Sec. 18, T. 20 S., R. 62 E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the W 1/2 corner of said Sec. 18 bears N. 43° 00' W., 70.7 feet situated in Clark County, State of Nevada.

Now Know YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 46, Statutes of 1937 has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: B. D. and Aileen Lee Davis
Post-office address: 1250 South Seventh Street, Las Vegas, Nevada
Amount of appropriation: 0.50 c.f.s. or not to exceed 110 acre-feet per season
Period of use, from March 1st to November 1st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation: September 20, 1950

Description of land to which water is appurtenant: 22 acres in the NW 1/4 SW 1/4 of Sec. 18, T. 20 S., R. 62 E., M.D.B.&M. Water is developed by means of a drilled well 350 feet deep cased with 150 feet of 10-inch casing and equipped with a fifteen H.P. Eryon Jackson electric turbine pump with 150 feet of five-inch column.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
