CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Margaret Amundson has presented to the State Engineer

of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from

Lake Tahoe

through pump, pipeline and tank for

Domestic

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: At a point which bears N. 47° 30' W., 348 feet from the meander corner of Sections 15 and 22, T. 14 N., R. 18 E., M.D.B.&M.

situated in Douglas County, State of Nevada.

Now Know Ye, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 46, Statutes of 1937

has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: Kenneth and Margaret Amundson

Post-office address: Glenbrook, Nevada

* Amount of appropriation: 0.001 c.f.s.

* Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year

Date of priority of appropriation: August 13, 1947

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:

Water is pumped directly from Lake Tahoe through 200 feet of 2-inch pipeline into a 500 gallon pressure tank; thence conveyed to the residence. The place of use is within Lot 4 and the SE¹ SE¹ of Sec. 15, T. 14 N., R. 18 E., M.D.B.&M.

*NOTE: This certificate is issued subject to the provision that the use shall not exceed 650 gallons per day between June 1st and September 15th of each year and intermittent use during the non-summer season on the basis of not to exceed fifty gallons of water per capita per day.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
