CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Lester Moncrief, Acting Regional Forester has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Lake Tahoe

through pipelines and storage tank for Recreational and Domestic

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NE 1/4 NE 1/4 Sec. 21, T. 13 N., R. 18 E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the N.E. corner of said Sec. 21 bears N. 31° 45' E., 718 feet

situated in Douglas County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 46, Statutes of 1937 has determined the date, source,

purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: United States of America, U. S. Forest Service

Post-office address: Ogden, Utah

Amount of appropriation: 0.10 c.f.s.

Period of use, from May 1st to October 31st of each year

Date of priority of appropriation: September 25, 1947

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use: Water is pumped from Lake Tahoe through a 4-inch pipeline about 1500 feet long to an elevated tank of 10,000 gallons capacity. From tank water is conveyed through 4-inch pipes to laterals which conveys water to place of use within Lots 1 and 2, Section 22, T. 13 N., R. 18 E., M.D.B.&M.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
