CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS W. H. Settlemeyer, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Underground (Well No. 1) through trench, pipeline and trough for Stockwatering

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: Within the SW 1/4 NW 1/4 Sec. 27, T. 28 N., R. 68 E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the NW corner of Sec. 9, T. 28 N., R. 67 E., bears N. 64° 20' 37" W., 41,168.5 feet situated in Elko County, State of Nevada.

Now Know YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 46, Statutes of 1937 has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Amount of appropriation 0.002 c.f.s. or sufficient to water 65 cattle
Period of use, from January 1 to December 31 of each year
Date of priority of appropriation January 15, 1951

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use: Water is developed by means of a trench 0 to 10 feet deep and 235 feet long; thence conveyed to a wooden trough 12 feet long, 1.5 feet wide and 1.0 feet deep through 235 feet of 1-inch pipeline. The place of use is within the same subdivision as the point of diversion.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
