CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Raymond Labarry has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Underground (South Well) through well, windmill and troughs for Stockwatering

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: Within the NW 1/4 SW 1/4 Sec. 29, T. 21 N., R. 54 E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the E 1/2 corner of said Sec. 29 bears N. 83° 03' E., 4,080 feet situated in Eureka County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 46, Statutes of 1937 has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: Raymond Labarry
Post-office address: Eureka, Nevada
Amount of appropriation: 0.036 c.f.s. or sufficient to water 4500 sheep and 250 cattle
Period of use, from: January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation: December 19, 1949

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use: Water is developed by means of a well equipped with a windmill and jet pump; thence conveyed to two steel troughs 14' x 4' x 3' and 40 feet of galvanized iron sheep troughs. The place of use is within the same subdivision as the point of diversion.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
