CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Jean A. Prentiss has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Underground through well and ditches for Irrigation and Domestic

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: In the NE 1/4 NE 1/4 Sec. 33, T. 41 N., R. 37 E., or at a point from which the N.E. corner of said Sec. 33 bears N. 68° 27' 30" E., 920 feet situated in Humboldt County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 46, Statutes of 1937 has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator Jean A. Prentiss

Post-office address Winnemucca, Nevada

Amount of appropriation 1.0 c.f.s. and not to exceed 4 acre-feet per acre irrigated

Period of use, from March 15th to September 30th of each year

Date of priority of appropriation May 17, 1948

Description of lands to which water is appurtenant: 12.0 acres in the W 1/2 NE 1/4 NE 1/4 Sec. 33, T. 41 N., R. 37 E., M.D.B.&M. Water developed by means of a well 28 feet deep cased with 28 feet of 16-inch casing.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
