CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, John P. Wright has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Underground through well, pump, tank and pipeline for Domestic and Farmstead purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: Within the SE 1/4 SW 1/4 Sec. 5, T. 7 S., R. 61 E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the S 1/4 corner of said Sec. 5 bears S. 59° 10' 15" E., 1,511.3 feet situated in Lincoln County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 46, Statutes of 1937 has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Amount of appropriation: 0.133 c.f.s.
Period of use, from: January 1 to December 31 of each year
Date of priority of appropriation: May 7, 1949

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use: Water is developed by means of a drilled well 70 feet deep cased with 6-inch casing and equipped with a 5 H.P. electric turbine pump; thence conveyed to a 30,000 gallon concrete storage tank; thence conveyed through a water system consisting of 2,450 feet of 5-inch, 1,140 feet of 4-inch, 1,150 feet of 3-inch, and 5,520 feet of 2-inch pipeline. The place of use is within the W 1/2 SE 1/4 and E 1/2 SW 1/4 Sec. 5, T. 7 S., R. 61 E., M.D.B.&M.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
