CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Walter G. Reid, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Underground (Well No. 1) through well, pump and ditches for Irrigation

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: Within the SW 1/4 SW 1/4 Sec. 9, T. 7 N., R. 25 E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the NE 1/4 corner of said Sec. 9 bears N. 29° 10' 30" E., 4,696.7 feet situated in Lyon County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72 Chapter 46, Statutes of 1937 has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

*NOTE: The waters under this certificate are comingled with the waters under other permits. The total duty of water from all sources shall not exceed that established under the Walker River Decree.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
