

THE STATE OF NEVADA
CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Dan S. Berg has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Gold Hill Spring through trench, pipeline and troughs for Stockwatering

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: Within the NE 1/4 SE 1/4 Sec. 33, T. 11 N., R. 44 E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the W 1/4 corner of said Sec. 33 bears N. 76° 56' W., 4,450 feet situated in Nye County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 46, Statutes of 1937 has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Post-office address Round Mountain, Nevada
Amount of appropriation 0.009 c.f.s. or sufficient to water 292 cattle
Period of use, from September 15 to December 31 and January 1 to June 15 of each year
Date of priority of appropriation April 9, 1951

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water is developed by means of a wing trench which has been tiled and filled with gravel; thence conveyed through 20 feet of 2-inch and 45 feet of 1 1/2-inch pipeline to two troughs five feet square and 14 inches deep. The place of use is within the same subdivision as the point of diversion.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
