CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, E. S. Bowman has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Elmer's Spring through ditch, tank and pipeline for Stockwatering

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: Within the NW 1/4 NE 1/4 Sec. 15, T. 21 S., R. 53 E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the NE corner of Sec. 13, T. 21 S., R. 53 E., bears N. 87° 05' E., 12,217 feet situated in Nye County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 46, Statutes of 1937, has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: E. S. Bowman
Post-office address: Pahrump, Nevada
Amount of appropriation: 0.0008 c.f.s. or sufficient to water 25 cattle
Period of use, from: January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation: August 13, 1951

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use: Water is conveyed from the spring to a tank by means of a ditch 40 feet long; thence overflow from this tank is conveyed through a 2-inch pipeline into a clay tank. The cattle water from both tanks. The place of use is within the same subdivision as the point of diversion.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
