CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, George R. Fettic has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Underground through well, pump, pressure tank & pipeline for Irrigation and Domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: Within the NE 1/4 SW 1/4 Sec. 21, T. 15 N., R. 20 E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the W 1/4 corner of said Sec. 21 bears N. 65° 51' 40" W., 2,276.8 feet situated in Ormsby County, State of Nevada.

Now Know YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 46, Statutes of 1937 has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Amount of appropriation: 0.04 c.f.s.
Period of use, from: January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation: April 10, 1950

Description of land to which water is appurtenant: 2.0 acres in the E 1/2 NE 1/4 SW 1/4 of Sec. 21, T. 15 N., R. 20 E., M.D.B.&M. Water is developed by means of a drilled well 78 feet deep cased with 4-inch casing and equipped with a windmill; thence conveyed through approximately 100 feet of one-inch pipeline to a pressure tank; thence conveyed through a pipeline to the house and sprinkling system.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
