

THE STATE OF NEVADA CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Harry H. Hughes has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Underground (Manhattan Gulch) through ponds and pump for Placer Mining

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: Within the SW 1/4 Sec. 23, T. 8 N., R. 43 E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the NE corner of said Sec. 23 bears N. 41° 30' E., 3,550 feet situated in Nye County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 46, Statutes of 1937 has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Period of use, from January 1 to December 31 of each year
Date of priority of appropriation September 4, 1947

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water is developed by means of dredged ponds in Manhattan Gulch which accumulate and store seepage. It is then pumped from the ponds to placer washing plants where it is used to wash gravel. After being used to wash gravel it returns to the ponds. The place of use is within the NE 1/4 NW 1/4 Sec. 21, T. 8 N., R. 43 E., M.D.B.&M., unsurveyed.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
