CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Leroy, James and Howard Sharp has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Cazier Spring through pipeline and trough for Stockwatering purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: Within the SW 1/4 Sec. 21, T. 8 N., R. 58 E., M.D.B. & M., unsurveyed, or at a point from which the SW corner of Sec. 26, T. 8 N., R. 57 E., bears S. 74°52'40"W., 25.191 feet situated in Nye County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 46, Statutes of 1937 has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator Leroy, James and Howard Sharp

Post-office address Blue Eagle Ranch, Tonopah, Nevada

Amount of appropriation 0.011 c.f.s. or sufficient to water 350 cattle

Period of use, from January 1 to December 31 of each year

Date of priority of appropriation October 2, 1948

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use: Water is conveyed from the spring through approximately 100 feet of one inch pipeline to a watering trough 15 feet long, 2 1/2 feet wide and 2 feet deep. The place of use is within the same subdivision as the point of diversion.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
