CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Leroy, James and Howard Sharp has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Sawmill Spring through dam and reservoir for Stockwatering

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: Within the NW 1/4 Sec. 18, T. 7 N., R. 59 E., M.D.B.&M., unsurveyed, or at a point from which the SW corner of Sec. 26, T. 8 N., R. 57 E., bears N. 66° 01' W., 47,541 feet situated in Nye County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 46, Statutes of 1937 has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: Leroy, James and Howard Sharp
Post-office address: Blue Eagle Ranch, Tonopah, Nevada
Amount of appropriation: 0.011 c.f.s. or sufficient to water 350 cattle
Period of use, from January 1 to December 31 of each year
Date of priority of appropriation: October 2, 1948

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water is impounded in a reservoir formed by the construction of an earth dam 10 feet long and 6 feet high across the channel. Stock water directly from the reservoir. The place of use is within the same subdivision as the point of diversion.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
