CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, L. B. Spencer, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Willow Creek through dam and ditches for Irrigation

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: Within the NW 1/4 SE 1/4 Sec. 27, T. 11 N., R. 44 E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the W 1/4 corner of said Sec. 27 bears 86° 07' W., 2,793 feet situated in Nye County, State of Nevada.

Now Know YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 46, Statutes of 1937 has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: James Bobb
Post-office address: Reese River, via Austin, Nevada
Amount of appropriation: 0.75 c.f.s. or not to exceed 40 acre-feet per season
Period of use, from March 1 to December 1 of each year
Date of priority of appropriation: July 17, 1951

Description of land to which water is appurtenant:

- 5.0 acres in the SE 1/4 NE 1/4 of Sec. 28, T. 11 N., R. 44 E., M.D.B.&M.
1.0 acres in the SW 1/4 NW 1/4 of Sec. 27, T. 11 N., R. 44 E., M.D.B.&M.
2.0 acres in the S 1/2 NW 1/4 of Sec. 27, T. 11 N., R. 44 E., M.D.B.&M.
8.0 acres total.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
