CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Sadie L. Epperson has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from

Medicine Spring

through pump and pipeline for

Domestic

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: Within the SW 1/4 SW 1/4 Sec. 32, T. 29 N., R. 60 E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the SW corner of said Sec. 32 bears S. 67° 37' W., 1,188 feet

situated in Elko County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 46, Statutes of 1937 has determined the date, source,

purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Amount of appropriation 0.02 c.f.s.

Period of use, from January 1 to December 31 of each year

Date of priority of appropriation September 13, 1949

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:

Water is pumped from ponds at the springs; thence conveyed through a pipeline to the places of use which are within the same subdivision as the point of diversion.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
