CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Arthur Shuey, Regional Engineer has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from White Spot Spring through pipeline and trough for Stock and Wildlife Watering purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: Within the NE 1/4 SE 1/4 Sec. 36, T. 17 S., R. 60 E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the SW corner of T. 17 S., R. 60 E., bears S. 86° 39' W., 30,592 feet situated in Clark County, State of Nevada.

Now Know YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 46, Statutes of 1937 has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: Fish & Wildlife Service, U.S. Dept. of Interior
Post-office address: Interior Bldg., Portland 14, Oregon
Amount of appropriation: 0.00049 c.f.s.
Period of use, from: January 1 to December 31 of each year
Date of priority of appropriation: October 30, 1950

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use: Water is conveyed from the spring through a pipeline to a 6-foot stock tank. The place of use is within the same subdivision as the point of diversion.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
