CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Arthur Shuey, Regional Engineer has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Cougar Spring

through pond for Stock and Wildlife Watering

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: Within the NW 1/4 NE 1/4 Sec. 9, T. 18 S., R. 55 E., M.D.B. & M., or at a point from which the NE corner of Sec. 3, T. 18 S., R. 55 E., bears N. 50° 30' E., 9,552.5 feet situated in Clark County, State of Nevada.

Now Know Ye, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 46, Statutes of 1937 has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Amount of appropriation 0.0005 c.f.s.

Period of use, from January 1 to December 31 of each year

Date of priority of appropriation July 16, 1951

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use: Water is developed by cleaning out the spring forming a pond from which the animals water. The place of use is within the same subdivision as the point of diversion.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
