

To change point of diversion, manner and place of use under Permit 11851 THE STATE OF NEVADA

CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Arthur Shuey, Regional Engineer has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Cold Springs

through ditches and ponds for Fish Culture and Domestic

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: Within the NE 1/4 SE 1/4 Sec. 1. T. 18 S., R. 55 E., M.D.B.&M. or at a point from which the E 1/2 corner of said Section 1 bears N. 40° 21' E., 1,663 feet situated in Clark County, State of Nevada.

Now Know YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 46, Statutes of 1937 has determined the date, source,

purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

* Amount of appropriation 4.0 c.f.s.

Period of use, from May 1st to September 30th of each year

** Date of priority of appropriation May 17, 1947

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:

Water is diverted from the stream bed by means of a dam and a diversion ditch; it is then conveyed to three fish cultural ponds and to a series of small ponds for fish where it is used for fish culture and recreation purposes. A portion of the water is also used for domestic purposes throughout the year.

*This certificate is issued subject to that certain agreement dated November 22, 1949 between C. D. Baker and Henry Hunt, parties of the first part and the U. S. of America by and through the Secretary of the Interior, parties of the second part. **This certificate changes the point of diversion, manner and place of use under Permit No. 11851 hence the priority of appropriation under this certificate remains the same as that under Permit No. 11851.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
