CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Paul Taddey has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Underground through well, pump, tank and pipelines for Domestic

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: Within the SW<sup>1</sup> NW<sup>1</sup> Sec. 22, T. 21 S., R. 61 E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the NW corner of said Sec. 22 bears N. 28° 45' W., 2,181.0 feet situated in Clark County, State of Nevada.

Now Know YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 46, Statutes of 1937 has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Period of use, from January 1 to December 31 of each year  
Date of priority of appropriation February 19, 1941

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:  
Water is developed by means of a drilled well approximately 700 feet deep, cased with 6-inch and 8-inch casing. Water is pumped from the well with a one-half H.P. pump and conveyed into a 50 gallon pressure tank; thence by pipelines to the place of use within the SW<sup>1</sup> NW<sup>1</sup> Sec. 22, T. 21 S., R. 61 E., M.D.B.&M.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
