CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, H. R. Humphrey has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Jeff Davis Spring through ditch and reservoir for Stockwatering and Domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: Within the SE 1/4 NE 1/4 Sec. 30, T. 2 S., R. 37 E., M.D.B.&M. or at a point from which the SW corner of Sec. 18, T. 2 S., R. 37 E. bears N. 79° 20' W., 31,970 feet situated in Esmeralda County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 46, Statutes of 1937 has determined the date, source,

purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Amount of appropriation cattle and 50 horses

Period of use, from January 1 to December 31 of each year

Date of priority of appropriation October 14, 1947

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use: Water is diverted from the spring through a ditch 40 feet long, 1 foot wide, and 1 foot deep into a reservoir 12 feet long, 8 feet wide, and 4 feet deep, where it is used for watering livestock. The place of use is within the same subdivision as the point of diversion.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
