CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS Maryly Krusi Taylor has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Lake Tahoe

through pump, pressure tank and pipelines for Domestic purposes.

The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: At a point which bears S. 15° 21' W., 572 feet from the meander corner of Sections 3 and 10, T. 14 N., R. 18 E., M.D.B.&M.

situated in Douglas County, State of Nevada.

Now Know YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 46, Statutes of 1937 has determined the date, source,

purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Period of use, from January 1 to December 31 of each year

Date of pricity of appropriation July 1, 1947

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use: Water is diverted from Lake Tahoe by means of an intake pipe 800 feet long and 2 inches in diameter and electrically operated pump; thence it is conveyed to a pressure tank and a distribution system which serves a dwelling and gardens. The place of use is within Lot 1, Sec. 10, T. 14 N., R. 18 E., M.D.B.&M.

*This certificate is issued with the understanding that the total use shall not exceed 650 gallons per day between June 1st and September 15th of each year, and that intermittant use during the non-summer season shall not exceed 50 gallons per capita per day.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
