CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Robert F. Guinn has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Lake Tahoe

through pump and pipelines for Domestic purposes.

The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: At a point which bears N. 66° 55' W., 1,225 feet from the meander corner of Sections 3 and 10, T. 14 N., R. 18 E., M.D.B.&M.

situated in Douglas County, State of Nevada.

Now Know Ye, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 46, Statutes of 1937 has determined the date, source,

purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: Anthon B. and Lucille C. Robertson

Post-office address: Glenbrook, Nevada

* Amount of appropriation: 0.0016 c.f.s.

Period of use, from January 1 to December 31 of each year

Date of priority of appropriation: July 1, 1947

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:

Water is diverted from Lake Tahoe by means of a twin pumping system and is conveyed to two dwellings through pipelines. The place of use is within Lot 4 of Sec. 3, T. 14 N., R. 18 E., M.D.B.&M.

*This certificate is issued with the understanding that the total amount of water used shall not exceed 1000 gallons per day between June 1st and September 15th of each year, and intermittant use during the non-summer season shall not exceed 50 gallons per capita per day.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
