


THE STATE OF NEVADA
CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, J. V. Caselli has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Warm Spring sometimes called Hot Spring through flume, tank, dams and pipelines for Irrigation and Domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: Within the NW 1/4 SW 1/4 Sec. 20, T. 4 N., R. 50 E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the SW corner of Sec. 32, T. 4 N., R. 50 E., bears S. 4° 50' W., 12,665 feet situated in Nye County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 128, Statutes of 1931 has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

3.0 acres in the NE 1/4 NE 1/4 SW 1/4 Sec. 20, T. 4 N., R. 50 E., M.D.B.&M.
2.5 acres in the NW 1/4 NW 1/4 SE 1/4 Sec. 20, T. 4 N., R. 50 E., M.D.B.&M.
5.5 acres total.



The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
