CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Edward Rembert has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from

Underground

through well, pump and pipelines for Milling

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: Within the NW 1/4 NW 1/4 Sec. 6, T. 27 N., R. 32 E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the NE corner of said Sec. 8 bears N. 76° 23' E., 5,256.00 feet situated in Pershing County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 46, Statutes of 1937 has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Period of use, from January 1 to December 31 of each year
Date of priority of appropriation April 23, 1951

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water is developed by means of a drilled well 39 feet deep and cased the entire depth with 6-inch casing. Water is pumped from the well with a one-quarter H.P. electric motor and conveyed to the mill through 1 inch and 1 1/2 inch pipelines. The place of use is within the same subdivision as the point of diversion.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
