CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Alvin H. Cliff and James H. Lathrop have presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: Within the S 1/2 SW 1/4 Sec. 26, T. 17 N., R. 18 E., M.D.B.&M. or at points from which the SW corner of said Sec. 26 bears S. 42° 31' 25" W. 658.9 feet and the S 1/2 corner of said Sec. 26 bears S. 1° 25' 30" E., 773.1 feet

situated in Washoe County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 46, Statutes of 1937 has determined the date, source,

*The lands irrigated under this certificate are also irrigated with the waters of Franktown Creek and the total duty of water from all sources shall not exceed the duty to be established in the Franktown Decree.

**This certificate to change the point of diversion, manner of use and place of use of 5.5 c.f.s. of the waters of North Creek heretofore decreed under that certain judgment and decree dated February 8, 1892 and filed in Record Bk. D, pages 21-22, of Washoe County, Nevada, is issued subject to the conditions imposed in said decree, which provides a period of use on 1.875 c.f.s. during the months of June through October of each year and on 3.625 c.f.s. during the months of January, February and May through to December 31st of each year and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein. It is further understood that this certificate is subject to the terms and conditions set forth in that certain stipulation dated February 7, 1947 and filed in the office of State Engineer on February 14, 1947 between Virginia City Water Company, Henry E. Heidenreich, et al and Nevada Winters Sauer, Theodora W. Longabaugh and Theodora W. Longabaugh, as administratrix of the estate of Lewis Winters, deceased, and Archie C. Winters, deceased.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
