CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, W. H. Brown has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Underground through well, pump and pipelines for Irrigation and Domestic

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: Within the SW 1/4 SE 1/4 Sec. 19, T. 20 N., R. 20 E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the S 1/4 corner of said Sec. 19 bears S. 45° 00' W., 688.4 feet situated in Washoe County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 46, Statutes of 1937 has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Period of use, from April 1 to October 31 of each year
Date of priority of appropriation: July 12, 1948

Description of land to which water is appurtenant: 1 acre in the SW 1/4 SE 1/4 Sec. 19, T. 20 N., R. 20 E., M.D.B.&M.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
