CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, John Jay Casey has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Underground (Flag Well) through well, windmill, tank and trough for Stockwatering purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: Within the NE 1/4 NW 1/4 Sec. 32, T. 3 N., R. 48 E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the NW corner of T. 3 N., R. 48 E. bears N. 15° 19' W., 28,155 feet. situated in Nye County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 46, Statutes of -1937- has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator John Jay Casey
Post-office address Box 29, Fallon, Nevada
Amount of appropriation 0.031 cfs., or sufficient to water 1000 cattle.
Period of use, from January 1 to December 31 of each year
Date of priority of appropriation November 16, 1950

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water is developed by means of a drilled well 150 feet deep cased with 6 inch casing and equipped with a windmill; thence conveyed to a tank 9 feet high and 15 feet in diameter; thence conveyed to a watering trough 4 1/2 feet wide and 16 feet long. The place of use is within the same subdivision as the point of diversion.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
