

THE STATE OF NEVADA
CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, W. H. Settlemeyer, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Unnamed Springs through pipelines and storage tank for Mining and Domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: Within the NE 1/4 SE 1/4 Sec. 30, T. 29 N., R. 51 E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the SE corner of said Sec. 30 bears S. 22° 00' 20" E., 2,027.30 feet. situated in Eureka County, State of Nevada.

Now Know Ye, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 46, Statutes of -1937- has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: Simplot Iron Mines, Inc.
Post-office address: W. H. Settlemeyer, P.O. Box 349, Elko, Nevada
Amount of appropriation: 0.07 cfs.
Period of use, from: January 1 to December 31 of each year
Date of priority of appropriation: February 1, 1952

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use: Water is conveyed from the springs through pipelines to a small storage tank; thence distributed to the various places of use through a pipeline. The place of use is within the same subdivision as the point of diversion.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
