CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, W. H. Settelmeyer, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Underground (Stock Well No. 10) through well, windmill and troughs for Stockwatering purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: Within the NW¹ SW¹ Sec. 11, T. 29 N., R. 49 E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the SW corner of said Sec. 11 bears S. 4° 53' W., 1,470 feet situated in Eureka County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 46, Statutes of 1937 has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

 Amount of appropriation 0.0234 cfs., or sufficient to water 750 cattle.
 Period of use, from January 1 to December 31 of each year
 Date of priority of appropriation December 24, 1952

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use: Water is developed by means of a drilled well 298 feet deep cased with 6 inch casing and equipped with a windmill; thence conveyed to a 4,000 gallon metal trough and a 1,200 gallon circular wooden trough. The place of use is within the same subdivision as the point of diversion.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
