CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, A. R. Culver, Manager has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from

Mustang Spring

through Pipeline, tanks and sump for

Stockwatering

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: Within the SW 1/4 SE 1/4 Sec. 15, T. 34 N., R. 33 E., M.D.B.&M, or at a point from which the SW corner of Sec. 27, T. 34 N., R. 33 E., bears S. 19° 32' W., 11,870 feet

situated in Pershing County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 46, Statutes of 1937 has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator C. & M. Ranch Company

Post-office address Imlay, Nevada

Amount of appropriation 0.007 cfs., or sufficient to water 400 cattle

Period of use, from January 1 to December 31 of each year

Date of priority of appropriation March 2, 1953

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:

Water is conveyed from the spring through 2 1/2 miles of one inch pipeline to three steel tanks having a composite capacity of approximately 2400 gallons; thence the overflow from the tanks is conveyed by pipeline to a sump. The place of use is within the SW 1/4 SE 1/4 Sec. 15; NE 1/4 NE 1/4 Sec. 21 and NE 1/4 SW 1/4 Sec. 20, T. 34 N., R. 33 E., M.D.B.&M.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
