CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS William J. Johnstone has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source (Shorty's Well) through well, pump & pipelines for domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: Within the SE 1/4 NE 1/4 Section 18, T. 10 N., R. 22 E., M.D.B. & M. or at a point from which the NE corner of said Section 18 bears N. 18° 35' E., 2,068.0 feet situated in Douglas County, State of Nevada.

Now Know Ye, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 46, Statutes of 1937 has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Amount of appropriation: 0.10 c.f.s.
Period of use, from: January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation: August 13, 1951

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water is developed by means of a drilled well 153 feet deep, cased with 6 inch casing and equipped with a 1 1/2 inch Bushley pump driven by a 1 1/2 H.P. electric motor. Water is conveyed to a cafe and lawn through a pipeline. The place of use is within the same subdivision as the point of diversion.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
