CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, John Jay Casey has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Dry Lake Drainage through Jackpot Reservoir through reservoir for Stockwatering

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: Within the SE¹ SE¹ Sec. 9, T. 5 S., R. 50 E., M.D.B.&M., unsurveyed, or at a point from which the SW corner of Sec. 31, T. 4 S., R. 51 E. bears N. 60° E., 18,480 feet. situated in Nye County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 46, Statutes of 1937 has determined the date, source,

purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator John Jay Casey
Post-office address Tonopah, Nevada
Amount of appropriation 7.0 acre-feet, or sufficient to water 600 cattle.
Period of use, from January 1 to December 31 of each year
Date of priority of appropriation June 12, 1946

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water is developed by means of a reservoir 50 feet in diameter and 12 feet deep which impounds the runoff from the dry lake. The place of use is within the same subdivision as the point of diversion.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
