CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, C. V. Taylor, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source (East Well) through pipeline and tanks for stockwatering and domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: Within the SW 1/4 SE 1/4 Sec. 23, T. 18 N., R. 40 E., M.D.M., or at a point from which the SE corner of Sec. 24, T. 18 N., R. 40 E., bears S. 84° 24' 20" E., 7,095 feet. situated in Lander County, State of Nevada.

Now Know YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 46, Statutes of 1937 has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water developed by means of a well 168 feet deep cased with 100 feet of 10 inch casing. Water diverted by means of a pump powered by a gasoline engine and conveyed through a short pipeline to two stockwatering tanks. Place of use is within the said SW 1/4 SE 1/4 Section 23, T. 18 N., R. 40 E. and there used to water 200 head of cattle.

\* In accordance with the ruling under this application dated August 4, 1949 the period of use is limited to fall, winter and spring.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
