CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Howard N. Sharp has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from

The Seeps (Seep No. 1) through reservoir, pipeline and tank for Stockwatering and Domestic

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: Within the NE 1/4 NW 1/4 Sec. 2, T. 1 N., R. 54 E., M.D.B.&M., unsurveyed, or at a point from which the SW Corner of Sec. 36, T. 1 N., R. 53 E., bears S. 43° 13' 40" W., 41,939 feet. situated in Lincoln County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 46, Statutes of 1937 has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: H. N. Sharp
Post-office address: Cross L Ranch, Tonopah, Nevada
Amount of appropriation: 0.0031 cfs., or sufficient to water 100 cattle
Period of use, from January 1 to December 31 of each year
Date of priority of appropriation: March 25, 1949

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:

Water is diverted from the spring into a small reservoir; thence conveyed through 200 feet of 1 1/2 inch pipeline to a round stockwatering tank 10 feet in diameter and 2 feet deep. The place of use is within the same subdivision as the point of diversion.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
