WHEREAS, Dwight G. Vedder has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from

NOTE: The waters under this Certificate are comingled with the waters under other Permits and Decreed Rights; the total duty of water from all sources, however, shall not exceed 3.60 acre-feet per season.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
