CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Wm. M. Esser has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Lake Tahoe through pump, pipeline and pressure tank for Domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: Within the NW 1/4 NE 1/4 Sec. 10, T. 14 N., R. 18 E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point which bears S. 5° 30' W., 1,090 feet from the meander corner between Secs. 3 & 10, T. 14 N., R. 18 E., M.D.B.&M. situated in Douglas County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 46, Statutes of 1937 has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Period of use, from January 1 to December 31 of each year
Date of priority of appropriation July 17, 1953

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water is diverted from Lake Tahoe by means of an intake pipe composed of 653 feet of 2 1/2 inch and 72 feet of 2 inch pipe connected to a 2 HP centrifugal pump; thence conveyed through 220 feet of 1 1/2 inch pipeline into a 315 gallon pressure tank; thence conveyed to the dwelling and lawn through conventional plumbing. The place of use is within the same subdivision as the point of diversion.

NOTE: This Certificate is issued subject to the condition that the total use shall not exceed 1000 gallons per day between June 1st and September 15th of each year, and that intermittent use during the non-summer season shall not exceed 50 gallons per capita per day.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
