CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS J. E. Cressman has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Tufly Spring through ditches for irrigation and domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: Within the SW 1/4 SW 1/4 Sec. 15, T. 15 N., R. 19 E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the SW Corner of said Sec. 15, bears S. 15° 19' 41" W., 999.87 feet. situated in Ormsby County, State of Nevada.

Now Know YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 46, Statutes of 1937 has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: William H. Long

Post-office address: P. O. Box 364, Carson City, Nevada

Amount of appropriation: 0.10 c.f.s.

\* Period of use, from July 1 to October 15 of each year

Date of priority of appropriation: February 28, 1949

Description of land to which water is appurtenant: 5.0 acres in the SW 1/4 SW 1/4 of Sec. 15, T. 15 N., R. 19 E., M.D.B.&M.

\*Note: This certificate is issued subject to the stipulation in the permit that the water right granted thereunder was for the irrigation of 5 acres of land from July 1st to October 15th of each year.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
