CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, C. A. Liddell, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Underground through well, pump, tank and pipeline for quasi-municipal and domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: Within the SW 1/4 SW 1/4 Sec. 14, T. 20 S., R. 53 E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the SW corner of said Sec. 14 bears S. 53° W., 1,550 feet. situated in Nye County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 46, Statutes of 1937 has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: Lionel A. Horgan
Post-office address: Pahrump, Nevada
Amount of appropriation: 0.01 c.f.s. but not to exceed 1440 gallons per day.
Period of use, from: January 1 to December 31 of each year
Date of priority of appropriation: July 20, 1954

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water is developed by means of a drilled well 325 feet deep cased with 100 feet of 8 inch casing and equipped with a 1 H.P. jet pump; thence conveyed to a 3,500 gallon steel tank through 4 1/2 feet of 1 inch pipeline; thence conveyed to a dwelling and bar through 87 feet of 1 inch pipeline. The place of use is within the same subdivision as the point of diversion.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
