THE STATE OF NEVADA CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, A. V. Tallman has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Eagle Creek through dam and ditches for irrigation and domestic

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: Within the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 6, T. 43 N., R. 38 E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the S.E. Corner of said Section 6 bears S. 43° 56' E., 3,440.0 feet. situated in Humboldt County, State of Nevada.
