CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, C. F. Cooney has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Underground through Well, pump and pipe lines for Municipal and Domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NE 1/4 SW 1/4 Sec. 17, T. 15N., R. 20 E., M.D.B. & M., or at a point from which the SW corner of said Sec. 17, bears S. 52° 47' 20" W., 2261 feet. situated in Ormsby County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 46, Statutes of 1937 has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation February 27, 1953

Description of place and manner of use: Water pumped from well (Orphan's Home Well) into pipe lines of State of Nevada as a supplemental supply for all State Buildings and Institutions in Sections 16, 17 and 18, T. 15N., R. 20 E., M.D.B. & M.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
