

THE STATE OF NEVADA CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Winfield G. Sholes has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from

Underground
through Well, ditches and pipe lines for
Irrigation and domestic

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SE 1/4 NE 1/4 Sec. 6, T. 21 S., R. 61 E., M.D.B.&M. or at a point from which the SE 1/4 corner of said Section 6, bears S. 58° 07' 30" E. 560 Feet. situated in Clark County, State of Nevada.

Now Know YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 46, Statutes of 1937 has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:



Amount of appropriation 0.02 c.f.s. or 12.5 Ac. Ft. per season
Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation October 2, 1944

Description of manner and place of use:
Water is developed by a well and conveyed through a ditch which is approximately one half mile long, and through various sizes and lengths of pipe and is used within an area of 2.5 acres in SE 1/4 NE 1/4 Sec. 6, T. 21 S., R. 61 E., M.D.B.&M.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
