

THE STATE OF NEVADA CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, W. H. Settelmeyer has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Underground (Well # 4) through Well and pipe lines for Municipal purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SW 1/4 SW 1/4 Sec. 4, T. 37 N., R. 62 E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the SW corner of said Sec. 4, bears S. 81° 55' W., 180.5 feet. situated in Elko County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 46, Statutes of 1937 has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

 Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year
 Date of priority of appropriation August 23, 1951

Description of place and manner of use:
Water is developed by a well 365' deep cased with 10" and 12" casing. Water is pumped to a 1,000,000 gallon capacity reservoir located in the SW 1/4 SW 1/4 Sec. 4 and thence distributed within the city limits of Wells, Nevada.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
