CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, G. Keith Hodson has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Underground (A seep) through pipe lines for mining, milling and domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NW 1/4 Lot 23 Section 2, T. 45 N., R. 26 E., M.D.B. & M., or at a point from which the NW corner of said Sec. 2, bears N. 21° 48' W., 7,425.73 feet. situated in Humboldt County, State of Nevada.

Now Know Ye, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 46, Statutes of 1937 has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: G. Keith and Agnes L. Hodson
Post-office address: Winnemucca, Nevada
Amount of appropriation: 0.02 c.f.s.
Period of use, from April 1st to November 1st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation: January 17, 1952

Description of place and manner of use: Water is conveyed by pipe line to the place of use within the NW 1/4 of lot 23, and NE 1/4 of lot 22 in Section 2, T. 45 N., R. 26 E. and there used for mining, milling and domestic purposes.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
