CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Paul W. Warner has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Warner Spring through dam and pipe lines for domestic and quasi-municipal purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NW 1/4 SW 1/4 Section 20, T. 22 S., R. 58 E., M.D.B. & M., or at a point from which the SW corner of said Sec. 20, bears S. 5° 30' W., 1,725 feet. situated in Clark County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 46, Statutes of 1937 has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Amount of appropriation 0.25 c.f.s.
Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation February 2, 1953

Description of place and manner of use: Water is collected by a dam and thence delivered to the place of use in the NE 1/4 SE 1/4 Section 19 and NW 1/4 SW 1/4 of Section 20, T. 22 S., R. 58 E., M.D.B. & M.; by varying size pipe lines for domestic and quasi-municipal use.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
