CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Jack D. Hensley has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from

underground through well, pipeline and troughs for stock and domestic

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SW 1/4 NW 1/4 Section 36, T. 16 N., R. 24 E., M.D.B. & M., or at a point from which the NE corner of said Sec. 36, bears N. 57° 29' E., 4,888 feet.

situated in Lyon County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 46, Statutes of 1937 has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator Jack D. Hensley

Post-office address San Marino, California

Amount of appropriation 0.0094 c.f.s. or sufficient to water 300 cattle.

Period of use, from November 1st to March 1st following year of each year

Date of priority of appropriation January 25, 1954

Description of place and manner of use: Water is pumped from a dug well through approximately 125 feet of pipe to troughs where it is used for watering 300 cattle within the same subdivision as the point of diversion.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
